

MASTERING INSPIRATION

OUTLINE OR DIAGRAM:

View your idea in a web or outline format

LINK:

Adding a link between two cells. Click here, then click on the beginning cell, then on the destination cell.

CREATE:

Notice the eight arrows. Choose an arrow to create a new cell.
